



COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

Full Access & Coordinated Transportation (FACT) is reaching out to the community to gather support and build partnerships that result in the creation of a coordinated system of specialized transportation that will provide rides to seniors, people with disabilities, low income families and other transportation disadvantaged residents of San Diego County.

The Community Partnership Program is open to all individuals, agencies, organizations, businesses, municipalities and elected officials who wish to express their support and desire to partner with FACT in the development of this new system of transportation.

The Community Partnership Program offers three different ways to demonstrate support:

Statement of Support:

A signed document, similar to a letter of support, indicating your support for the vision, and mission of FACT and the concepts of transportation coordination.

Community Partnership Agreement:

A signed document, expressing your support for the vision and mission of FACT, and stating that the person who signs or their agency or organization agrees to promote FACT in newsletters and other materials and attend FACT special events if they can. Additionally, FACT agrees to recognize the signing person or agency during all outreach and on the FACT website

Operating Partnership Pledge:

A signed document that contains the same information as the Agreement, and adds that the person or agency signing the pledge agree to participate in discussions with FACT to overcome barriers and solve problems relating to implementing coordinated transportation, and provide resources to FACT as the system develops and becomes operational.

A copy of these documents is included with this program description.

It is critical to the success of FACT that partners be identified and documented during the developmental phase of our work. The Community Partnership Program provides information and materials to solidify these partnerships.

How to Become Involved

1. Read the three documents and determine which is the most appropriate for demonstrating your support for FACT. (You can sign one or more than one)
2. Contact FACT if you have any questions or would additional information, including a formal presentation describing the history and goals of FACT.
3. Secure the necessary signature on the desired document(s) and send to the FACT office. Those documents needing a signature from FACT will be returned to you.
