

# **CAM Meeting Summary**

Tuesday, October 8, 2024, 1:30 PM

#### 1. Introductions and updates:

Chair Marilyn Greenblatt (JFS) welcomed everyone. Introductions and updates were made. Cycle 13 applications are due Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>. Ali Vazquez (SANDAG) said call for applications for used minivans is due December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Lisa Nokes said Peninsula Shepherd Center has rebranded its name to Peninsula Community Senior Center. Adrianna Yemhatpe said Travelers Aid Senior Rides Program is accepting applications, but will be put on a wait list. The Senior Solutions program is not accepting applications at this time.

# 2. SANDAG updates:

 Ben Gembler said SANDAG is finishing up the AFA Cycle 2 evaluation phase and will be releasing their funding recommendations in November. The recommendations will be presented to the Transportation Committee and Board in December for approval. Start time frame is anticipated to be January or February 2025.
